**1. Brief Description of the Project.**

The Sleepy Hollow Athletic League is trying to provide a safe environment for the youth in the neighborhood to play sports. Our basketball court is in poor condition with rusted out backboards and cracked playing area. New backboards will go a long way toward upgrading the playing experience for our youth. A resurfacing of the playing surface is in the works. This will allow us to enhance the programming at the court for the youth in the neighborhood.

As already stated we would like to increase the athletic programs at Sleepy Hollow Park. A summer Basketball league and Or Clinics would serve over 200 youth in the area. The back boards and court resurfacing will go a long way towards improving this site.

We have provided programs for T-ball, Coaches pitch, baseball, basketball, tennis, flag football, and cheerleading to name a few.

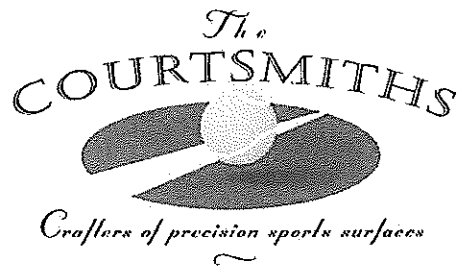


