

DPU TMACOG Fees

Bullet Points

- Engineering Services works through the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments (TMACOG) to acquire federal and state funding for infrastructure improvements.
- The annual cost for this membership is \$53,654.
- This expenditure is included in Engineering's Street, Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund 2021 operating budget.
- Environmental Services is a member of TMACOG's Stormwater Coalition.
- The annual cost for this membership is \$12,058.
- Clear Choices, Clean Water is an educational program provided to the citizens of northwest Ohio, helping to fill requirements that the Ohio EPA requires of the City of Toledo.
- The bi-annual cost of the license for this program is \$7,143.
- Environmental Services sponsors the Student Watershed Watch Program through TMACOG which is an annual educational program for Toledo area high school students providing test kits and student presentation funding.
- The annual cost for this sponsorship is \$9,950.
- The cost of the Stormwater Coalition dues, 2-year license agreement, and Student Watershed Watch Program are included in Environmental Services' 2021 stormwater operating budget.
- The City of Toledo as a whole is a member of TMACOG. The annual dues for this membership are \$72,798.
- This cost is through the general fund non-departmental 2021 operating budget. It is included in this legislation as a time saving measure to incorporate all annual dues to TMACOG so that payment can be made at one time.
