

Fire/EMS Districts




2024 Response Data

(Thru March, 2024)

- Total Incidents – **15,026**
 - 9% increase over 2023
 - Avg: 165/Day
- Fire Incidents – **2,300**
 - Working (Building) Fires: 60
- E.M.S. Incidents – **12,726**
- Total Responses for 2024 - **26,520**
 - 7% increase over 2023
 - Avg: 291/Day
