

STATE AIR GRANT 2021

BULLET POINTS

- The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) in 2019 awarded a grant for the amount of \$1,276,500 and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) awarded a grant for the amount of \$558,890 both of which were authorized to be deposited into the Operation Grant Fund. Subsequently, the OEPA increased their grant award by \$83,007 and USEPA reduced the grant award by \$14,670.
- Grant funds will be used to cover certain operational expenses for the Air Permitting and Monitoring Section of the Division of Environmental Services. The grant is to do the state and federally required air permitting and ambient air monitoring. By doing this locally, we give better service to the community.
- Grant funds the labor, including benefits and overhead, purchases of supplies, equipment, travel, vehicles, and other necessary items.
- No additional match is required for the additional funds.
