
Expansion Overview

The Office of the Mayor of the City of Toledo and The Village on Adams, Inc, a 501c(3) Non-Profit Organization (The Village), petition the Toledo City Council to approve and enact the expansion (The Expansion) of the Adams Street Outdoor Refreshment Area (The Adams St ORA), in accordance with Section 4301.82 of the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Substitute House Bill 47.

The Expansion would extend the Adams St ORA boundary at Adams Street and 12th Street one block to the North along 12th Street to include Quenched and Tempered Brewery, located on the northwest corner of the intersection of Jackson Street and 12th Street.

As outlined in this Petition, The Village will be working with the Mayor's office, Toledo City Council, The Toledo Police Department, and the Divisions of Safety, Sanitation, and Transportation officials to ensure a safe, professional implementation of The Expansion. Through constant communication with all affected City Departments, The Village will precisely tailor The Area security and sanitation needs as time and experience progress, as permitted in ORC 4301.82

Seven (7) "Adams St ORA" signs indicating The Expansion boundaries are required:

- Two (2) Large "ORA 12th Street Only to Jackson Street" signs facing South toward Adams, replacing the two (2) existing ORA Boundary signs on 12th Street at Adams
- Two (2) Large "ORA 12th Street Only to Adams Street" signs on both sides of 12th Street, at Jackson Street, facing North toward Jackson.
- One (1) "ORA Boundary" sign on the Southeast corner of 12th/Jackson intersection, facing South toward Adams.
- Two (2) "ORA via Crosswalk Only" signs, one at each end of Crosswalk
 - Southwest corner of 12th/Jackson intersection Crosswalk entrance, facing South toward Adams
 - o Northwest corner of 12th/Jackson intersection Crosswalk entrance, facing North

The Number of Personnel Needed to Ensure Public Safety in The Area

The current frequency of the Toledo Police Department patrol is quite sufficient in providing a very visible, consistent presence for the safety of Adams St ORA Patrons, as well as for the safety of the businesses and residents.

Business owners, residents, and patrons within the Adams St ORA have reported to the Village that TPD Response Times for calls for service are rapid and nearly always within the anticipated arrival times.

The City of Toledo Division of Transportation has lowered the speed limit from 35 MPH to 25 MPH through the ORA zone.

A Sanitation Plan That Will Help Maintain the Appearance and Public Health of The Area, Number of Personnel Required

Trash Receptacles for litter prevention and control:

Since its inception in 2014, the Village on Adams has been monitoring and adding resources for litter prevention and control. The Village has purchased, maintained, and hired personnel to empty 50 trash receptacles from 20th Street to 11th Street since the Adams St ORA's creation in 2015.

Through that monitoring, it has been determined that the most effective number of trash receptacles per East<->West oriented block of the Adams St ORA is three (3) receptacles per side of the street, or six (6) per block. For North<->South oriented blocks, the most effective number is four (4) per side of the street, or eight (8) per block. Two (2) trash receptacles are currently positioned on the Expansion block at the Adams Street end. Six (6) additional receptacles will be placed evenly into the Expansion to bring the total to eight (8) receptacles.

Litter patrol for the Adams St ORA has been performed as a Streetwide effort by all of the six (6) participating ORA Establishments, and has been more than effective at maintaining any and all litter generated by ORA Patrons. This will also be the case for the Expansion, as Quenched and Tempered has pledged its participation in keeping the Expansion litter-free.

Street Sweeping:

The City of Toledo Division of Streets, Bridges, and Harbors will continue its current schedule of street sweeping in the Adams St ORA and the Expansion.

Per request by the original Adams St ORA Petition in 2015, The City of Toledo Department of Public Service has committed to monitor the need and frequency for street sweeping and will adjust the schedule as necessary. The Village will monitor this schedule as well, and will request adjustments as necessary.

The number of personnel needed to execute the Sanitation Plan is four (4) for Trash Receptacle pickup, one (1) for Street Sweeping, and seven (7) for General Litter and Debris.

A Requirement That Beer and Intoxicating Liquor Be Served Solely in Plastic Bottles or Other Non-Glass Containers in the Area

All Adams St ORA Beverages shall only be served into, and consumed from, an Official Adams St ORA Cup (Official Cup). The Village orders and maintains the supply of Official Cups, and provides them, at cost, to each of the Adams St ORA Establishments.

In the interest of sustainability and reduced environmental impact, during Events held within the Adams St ORA and the Expansion, any non-glass container shall be acceptable for ORA Beverages for the duration of the Event. Once the Event is completed, the Official Cup shall again be required for all ORA Beverages.

Should there be an instance of limited Official Cup supplies or a shortage, unmarked plastic cups may be used until the shortage has been remedied.

The Village believes in aligning our missions with the leaders and organizations already invested in our region and our neighborhood. Two strong examples of such vision and foresight are the Toledo 20/20 Plan and the Uptown Master Plan, and both give recommendations that directly correlate to developments like an Adams Street Open Refreshment Area.

The Toledo 20/20 Plan:

Finished in 2013, recommends for Downtown neighborhoods in Section 167 on page 332: Creating entertainment and niche commercial development

The Uptown Master Plan:

Also finished in 2013, goes much further in respect to the Adams Street corridor in Uptown (11th St. to Woodruff Ave.):

Uptown Master Plan, Challenges and Solutions, page 28

Uptown's entertainment anchor is Adams Street. The taverns and restaurants in this corridor are the backbone for the neighborhood. The music scene attracts a variety of individuals to this street and more importantly establishes venues that put activity into the neighborhood, which also makes people feel secure since other similar people are visible on the street.

Uptown Master Plan, Uptown Association Priorities, page 45

Upon further examination of what the priorities should be for the uptown neighborhood, a list of 10 initiatives was created to provide a guide for the Uptown Association Board. The Uptown Association Board ranked the initiatives on the level of importance and despite the final rankings all of the initiatives had merit in regards to the vision for Uptown. **The highest rated initiatives were maintaining Adams Street as the center of Arts and Entertainment district** and creating housing around the Uptown Green Park. Instituting the Urban Disc Golf Course into the neighborhood and developing student housing for Mercy College followed next on level of importance.

<u>Prioritized summary of the Uptown Board's ranking of the 10 initiatives presented in the Uptown Plan:</u>

11 Votes: Adams Street as the center of Arts and Entertainment

11 Votes: Housing around Uptown Green

Continue to Promote Adams Street as the Center of Arts and Entertainment

Adams Street is the core of the residential, arts, and entertainment activity in Uptown. This street has the good building density; however, there are too often breaks along the street frontage that may afford an opportunity for additional development. Existing building stock should be stabilized, and a focus on strategic infill should be incorporated into the street especially at intersections. Another concept is to designate Adams Street as a local historic district. The overall goal for historic preservation in Toledo is to preserve and enhance the

unique historical and cultural heritage of a neighborhood. Historic preservation is important if the neighborhood is to continue to develop in a way that is authentically and uniquely Uptown. Uptown's sense of place is built to a great extent on the unique collection of historic buildings along Adams Street.

Rules of The Area

- A person may have in the person's possession an opened container of beer or intoxicating liquor at an outdoor location within an Outdoor Refreshment Area created under section 4301.82 of the Ohio Revised Code if the open container of beer or intoxicating liquor was purchased from a qualified permit holder to which both of the following apply:
 - (i) The permit holder's premise is located within the Outdoor Refreshment Area.
 - (ii) The permit held by the permit holder has an Outdoor Refreshment Area designation.
- Outdoor Refreshment Area Participants may NOT Enter the premises of an establishment within an Outdoor Refreshment Area while possessing an open container of beer or intoxicating liquor acquired elsewhere
- ALL beer, wine, or intoxicating liquor must be contained in the Official Cup of the The Area, with exceptions only permitted as outlined in section

Assumption of Good Behavior by ORA Participants:

An ORA Participant can expect to enjoy the Adams Street Outdoor Refreshment Area without restraint, questioning, or harassment by ORA Security, The Village, or any ORA entity **SO LONG AS** that ORA Participant correctly follows all of the Rules of The Area, and maintains a decorum of Good Behavior, free of public drunkenness, property destruction, or any action that disrupts the enjoyment of another ORA Participant, or disrupts any establishment, property owner, resident, or patron within the ORA.

***Violation of any of these <u>Rules of The Area</u> shall be considered a minor misdemeanor and violators face warnings and/or fines up to \$150.00 in accordance with ORC 4301.62
