

Dewatering System Rebuild Bullet Points

- The Water Reclamation Plant utilizes belt filter presses, conveyors, feed pumps, polymer pumps and associated electrical equipment to dewater waste sludge for disposal in accordance with the NPDES permit issued by the Ohio EPA.
- The existing equipment and systems are over 30 years of age and are beyond the intended service life, which if kept in service would threaten the operational integrity and jeopardize the NPDES discharge permit of the plant.
- The Division of Water Reclamation has received a quotation for the rebuild of the Belt Filter Presses and will seek competitive bids for all associated items listed above once funds become available.
- The Dewatering System Rebuild Project will address improvements necessary for the complete rebuild of half of the dewatering system.
- This ordinance authorizes the appropriation and expenditure of up to \$1,000,000 for the purchase of equipment and construction services related to the Dewatering System Rebuild Project.
