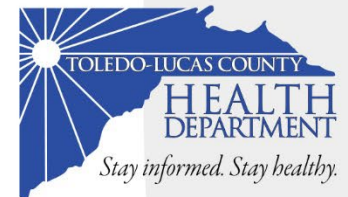

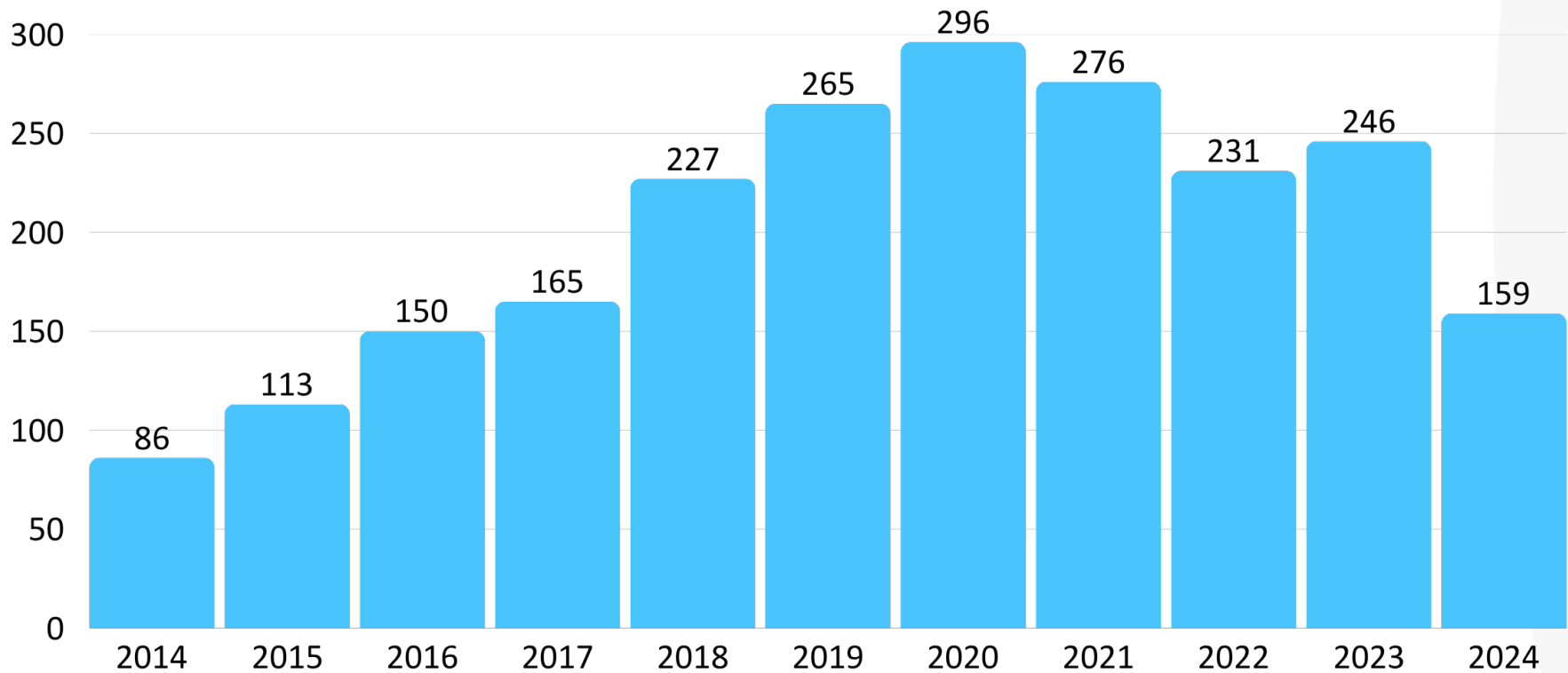

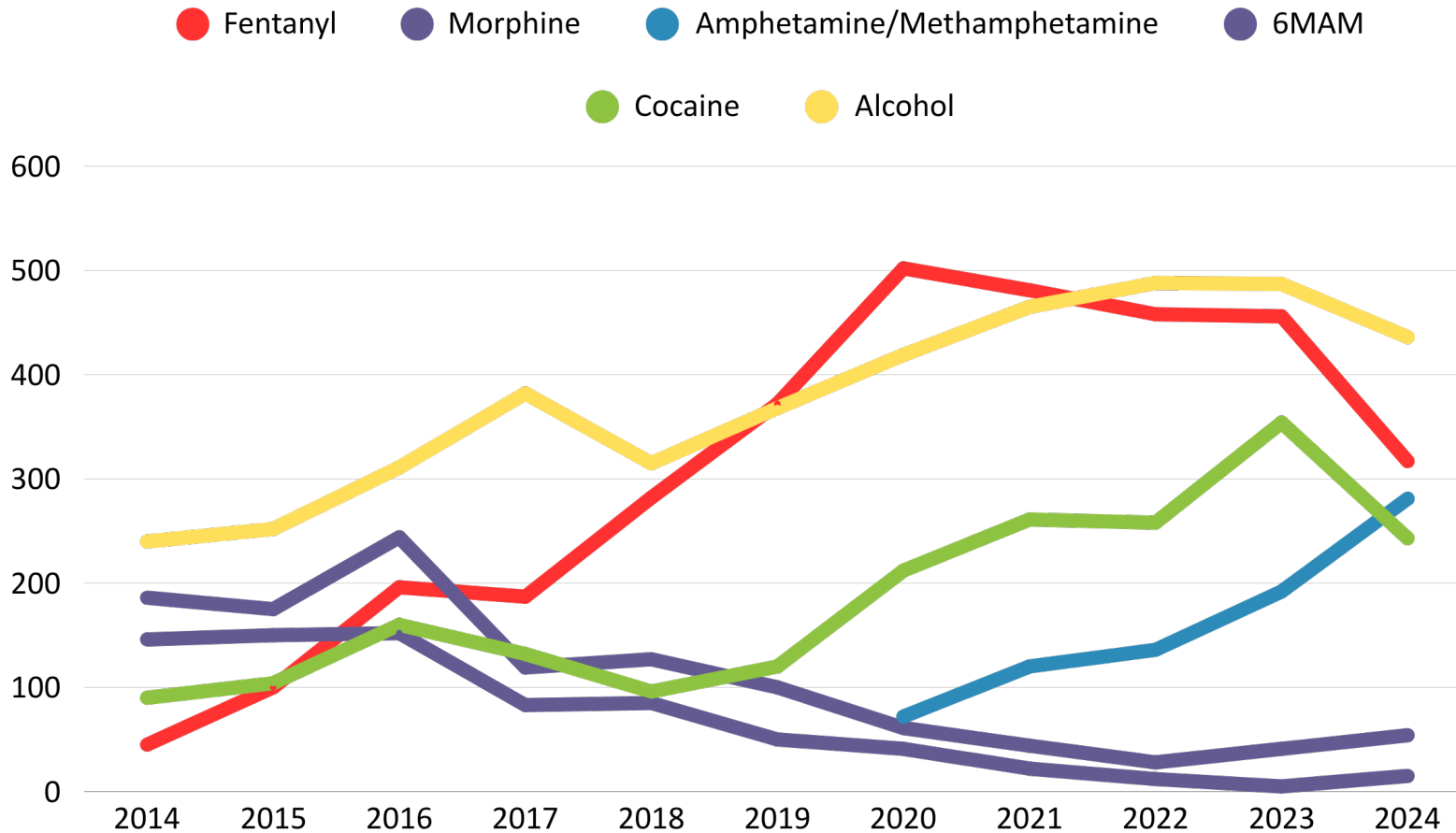
Opioid Related Fatalities Occurring in Lucas County 2014-2024

Drug Positivity Trends

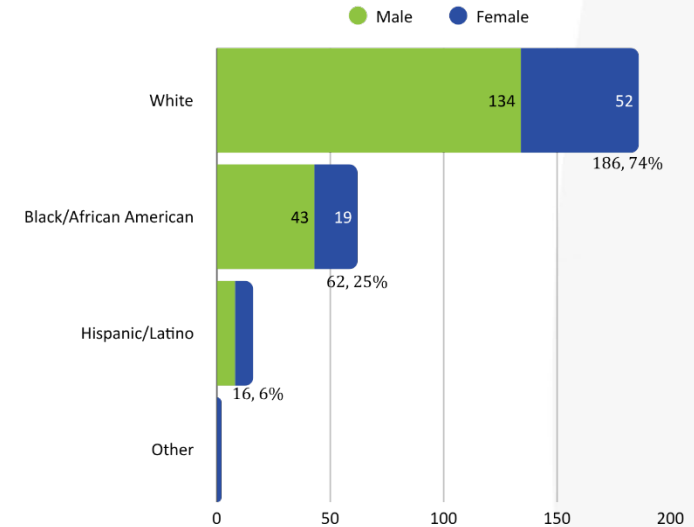
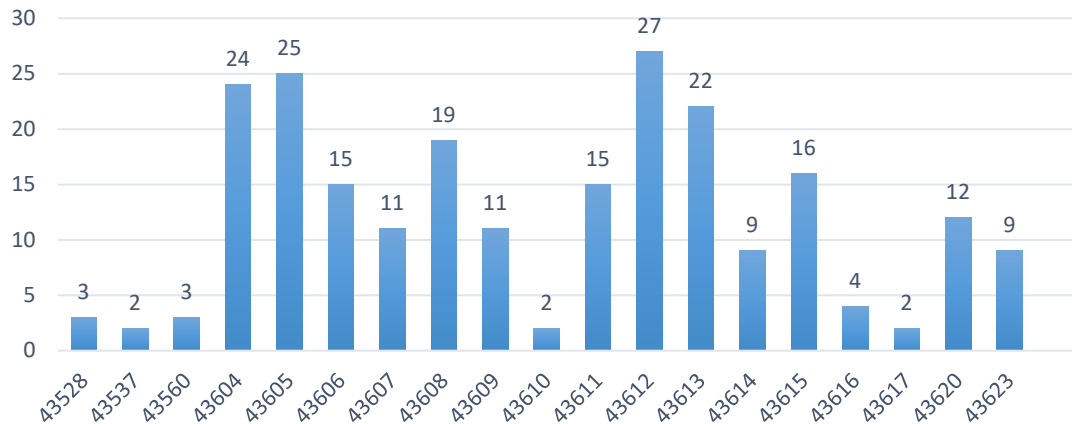
Drug Positivity Trends in Northwest Ohio 2014-2024

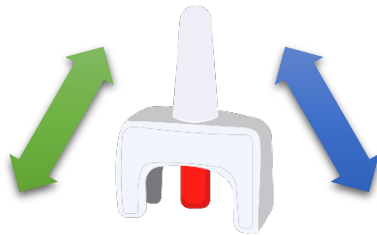

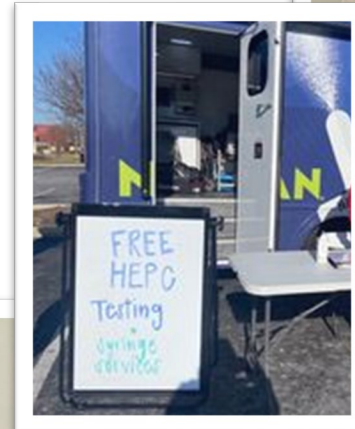
