[O-299-26](#) Authorizing the Mayor to enter into a three-year agreement, with two one-year renewal options, with Granicus, Inc.; waiving the competitive procurement requirements of TMC Chapter 187; authorizing the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$48,000 from the General Fund for annual subscription and maintenance costs for the Granicus Legislative Management Suite software; and declaring an emergency.

[R-300-26](#) Providing for an election on the question of the approval of the passage of an ordinance to amend Chapter 1905 of the Toledo Municipal Code to provide for a new temporary one-quarter percent (1/4%) municipal income tax for a period commencing January 1, 2027, and ending December 31, 2030, for the purpose of allocating the levy proceeds to the General Fund to be dedicated to neighborhood safety expenditures, and police and fire safety force operations, including criminal gang disruption; and declaring an emergency.
