- The City will spend \$2,232,000 on the 2020 Sidewalk program. \$1,232,000 is assessed to the property owner and \$1,000,000 is the City's responsibility for sidewalk raised by roots and the installation of pedestrian ramps adjacent to properties where work is being performed. This will come out of the Capital Improvement Program Fund.
