

Goals and Objectives

Implement a Drone as First Responder (DFR) program

The DFR program is on track. We are currently working through paperwork to attain a Certificate of Authorization (COA) from the Federal Aviation Administration. We are currently working out details on some electrical work, staging area for the DFR rooftop lift, and working with the helicopter company to set a date for installation.

Reduce the drug chemistry laboratory backlog by 10%

The Toledo Police Department Forensic Laboratory's drug backlog as of January 1, 2025 was 287 cases. The drug backlog at the end of March of 2025 is 245 cases, a 14.6% reduction.

Reduce fatal accidents by 10% through increased speed, seatbelt, and red light citations

In the first quarter of 2024 we recorded 5 fatal crashes resulting in 6 deaths. In the first quarter of 2025 we recorded 3 fatal crashes resulting in 3 deaths. This is a 40% decrease in fatal crashes and a 50% decrease in deaths.

Provide homicide investigation training at academy for newly assigned detectives in the Investigative Services Bureau

Six detectives are currently attending homicide investigation training.
