additional \$76,124.25 in Ohio Drug Law Enforcement Fund grant funds from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services to conduct drug investigations. The original grant was for \$44,643.61 (ORD. 278-17).

There is an in-kind match of \$25,375.66 required for this addition to the grant, which will be covered by personnel salaries. The grant funds will increase the department's ability to conduct drug enforcement investigations.

TMP-2397 Authorizing the Mayor to enter into cooperative grant agreements with and to accept financial assistance from the State of Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for LUC SR (Lucas County State Route) 51 (Monroe Street) Corridor Improvements; authorizing the Mayor to deposit grant proceeds into the Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$640,000; authorizing the appropriation and expenditure of said grant proceeds; authorizing the Mayor to execute all necessary documentation for the grants; authorizing the Mayor to accept bids and award contracts related to LUC SR 51 (Monroe Street) Corridor Improvements; and declaring an emergency.

## **Body:** SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

The Division of Transportation has been working closely with ODOT to secure grant dollars through a Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funding opportunity. The grant dollars awarded to the City require a 20% match. \$640,000 maximum has been allocated by ODOT through CMAQ funds. Therefore, the City's match on the total \$800,000 project is \$160,000. The engineer's estimate is \$701,000.

Passage of this Ordinance is required to enable the City of Toledo to accept outside funding for these projects and have it in place to help pay for these expenditures.
