STAFF ANALYSIS

The applicant is requesting a Special Use Permit for a Convenience Store located at 2067 Airport Highway. The ± 0.114 -acre site is comprised of one (1) parcel, which is a vacant two-story mixed use residential-commercial building on a corner lot constructed in 1919. Surrounding land uses include a tattoo parlor and single-family residential and residential duplexes to the north with single-family residential and residential duplexes to the west, east and south.

An overview of project details is included in this analysis. A detailed list of all project related items is included in the agency conditions at the end of this report.

Use Specific Regulations

Spacing Requirements: Per TMC 1104.0603 Location: A convenience store shall not be located within a 2,000-foot radius of another convenience store, whether that other convenience store is operating pursuant to a Special Use Permit or operating without such Special Use Permit by virtue of having been in operation prior to the requirement to obtain such permit. The proposed site is situated between two existing convenience stores: one which is 874' to the northeast and another which is 715' to the southwest. A convenience store shall not be located within a 1,000-foot radius of a school, public park, public library, licensed child day care center, or other use established specifically for the activities of minors. The proposed site is situated 878' west of Highland Park.

Hours of Operation: Per TMC 1104.0601 The hours of operation of a convenience store may be limited to 5:30 a.m. to 1 a.m. or other hours consistent with a liquor permit issued by the State of Ohio, as a condition of development approval. Particular attention will be given to convenience stores located adjacent to any residential district, school, place of religious assembly, park, or playground. The applicant's letter of intent does not indicate hours of operation. Hours of operation are limited to 5:30 a.m. to 1 a.m. as a condition of approval, if the SUP is approved.

STAFF ANALYSIS (cont'd)

Negative Secondary Effects: Per TMC 1104.602 The Special Use permit granted for a convenience store shall be subject to review on an annual basis and may be amended or revoked by action of City Council in consultation with the Plan Commission if said convenience store is determined to have significant negative secondary effects that have not been sufficiently alleviated under zoning, building or health code regulations. Negative secondary effects are defined as:

- a. Litter, broken bottles and paper discards that diminish the aesthetics of the immediate area.
- b. Noise, disruption from the carryout to the quiet enjoyment of adjoining residential districts, and public and civic uses.
- c. Traffic, traffic noise and congestion.
- d. Pedestrian congestion which can intimidate individual patrons and disrupt neighborhood civility.

<u>Parking</u>

a. There is not adequate parking for the use as the on-street parking is for residences and customer parking is not allowable on the concrete pad in front of the garage. The Division of Transportation is requiring the addition of bicycle parking as well as a dumpster with the appropriate screening and concrete pad. All improvements are listed as conditions, if the SUP is approved.

Landscaping

a. The reuse of an existing site is not required to comply fully with current landscape standards, but must bring the site closer to compliance. Turf landscaping exists around the perimeter of the building with a small hedge in the front. With the change in zoning to Neighborhood Commercial, there must be a Type A landscape buffer between the convenience store and abutting residence. As there is an existing fence the buffer width can be ten feet (10'). However, the fifty-six (56') edge must have two (2) canopy trees and eight (8) shrubs to bring the site into compliance. A revised site plan indicating a Type A landscape buffer is listed as a condition, if the SUP is approved.

Elevations

- a. The building is existing, therefore there is no review of the building elevation.
- b. In keeping with current Plan Commission policy and the requirements of the updated Sign Code (soon to be adopted); new ground signage will be limited to low-profile monument signage, and is listed as a condition if the SUP is approved.

STAFF ANALYSIS (cont'd)

20/20 Plan

The *Toledo 20/20 Comprehensive Plan* targets this area as Single-family Residential, which is intended to accommodate the development of single dwelling units on individual lots. The districts are intended to create, maintain and promote housing opportunities for individual households, although they do permit nonresidential uses that are typically compatible with residential neighborhoods.

Staff is recommending disapproval of this SUP; however, review agency conditions are attached as Exhibit "A" for informational purposes.

PLAN COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

The Toledo City Plan Commission recommends disapproval of SUP-12002-21, a request for a Special Use Permit for a Convenience Store located at 2067 Airport Highway, to the Toledo City Council, for the following **three (3) reasons:**

- 1. The use does not comply with all applicable provisions of the Zoning Code **TMC 1111.0706.B**;
- 2. The use does not meet the spacing requirements of TMC.1104.0603 A & B; and
- 3. The use is not compatible with adjacent uses in terms of operating characteristics (such as noise, traffic generation, and other impacts associated with the use's operation) **TMC 1111.0706.C.**

- 2. All **proposed** sidewalk, drive approaches, curb, and pedestrian curb ramps within the public right-of-way shall be constructed in accordance with the City of Toledo Construction Standards, Specifications, Toledo Municipal Code, and Americans with Disabilities Act guidelines.
- 3. All commercial drive approaches, (along with the sidewalk through the drive) shall be constructed with 8" thick concrete per City of Toledo Construction Standards and Specifications. No curb shall be permitted in the right-of-way along either side of a drive approach. No horizontal curb cutting will be permitted to create a curb drop/opening. Existing drive approaches, including the curb drop, that will no longer be utilized shall be removed and restored with curb to match the adjacent curb.
- 4. Required permits for all approved work in the public right-of-way shall be obtained, before work begins, from One Stop Shop, (419) 245-1220.

Contact Joe Warnka at (419) 245-1341 for inspection of above-mentioned items.

5. Applicant is responsible for preventing stormwater pollution by using erosion and sediment control construction practices.

Sewer and Drainage Services

- 6. S&DS requires that all private sewer lines that are not being removed or properly abandoned (both storm & sanitary) be cleaned and inspected.
- 7. S&DS requires that the private sanitary lines (after they have been cleaned) that are not being removed or properly abandoned be televised from the building (or private cleanout) to where they connect to the public sewer system if this has not been done in the past (2) two years. An electronic (DVD/memory stick) shall be provided to S&DS demonstrating the lines cleaning and integrity.

Environmental Services

8. Applicant shall maintain compliance with the City of Toledo's Storm Water regulations as specified in the Toledo Municipal Code. Special attention must be paid to all potential storm water impacts from the modification of the site, including but not limited to long-term operation and maintenance of existing structural and non-structural Best Management Practices.

- 9. Applicant shall maintain compliance with Ohio EPA's General Storm Water NPDES permit programs.
- 10. Applicant is strongly encouraged to include multiple green infra-structure measures to minimize runoff and increase infiltration, and to minimize the amount of new and/or additional impervious surface on the site.
- 11. Applicant is strongly encouraged to plant native, low maintenance and non-invasive trees, shrubs and perennials.

- 12. Applicant shall maintain compliance with the City of Toledo and the State of Ohio's Air Quality Regulations applicable in the Toledo Municipal Code and the Ohio Administrative Code including, but not limited to the Asbestos and the Anti-Noise Laws.

Fire Department

- 13. It appears that this building will undergo a change of use. This will require compliance with all applicable Fire Sprinkler and Alarm, Building, Electrical, Mechanical and Plumbing code requirements.
- 14. Approved premise identification is required.

Transportation

- 15. Bicycle parking must be shown per TMC 1107.
- 16. Dumpster location must be shown on the site plan.
- 17. Parking on the concrete area cannot block the garage entrances.
- 18. Business access drives shall not be located across from a residential zone property. (Concrete Driveway and Alley)
- 19. Business parking cannot block residential on street parking.

20. Parking spaces shall not be allowed directly off of alley. Alley not wide enough for two-way traffic.

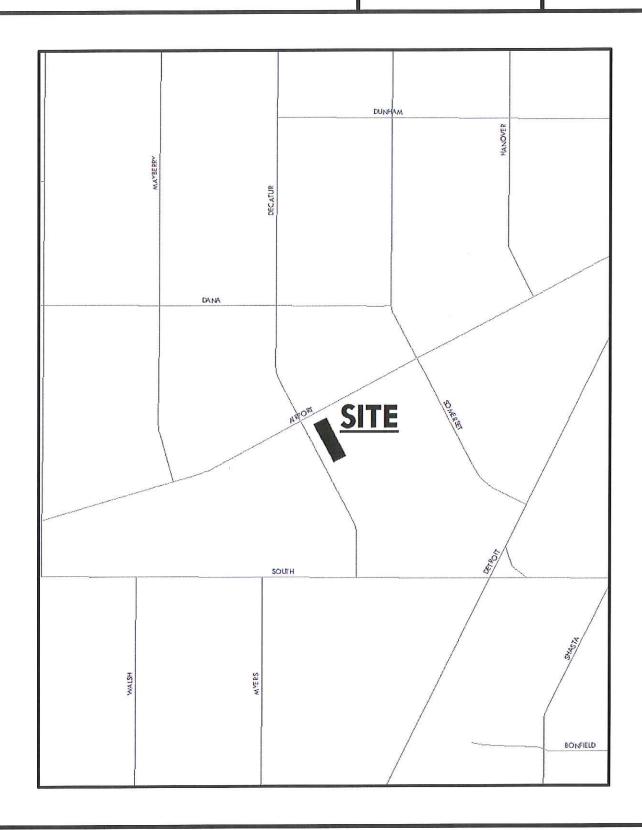

- 21. The hours of operation of a convenience store shall be limited to 5:30 a.m. to 1 a.m. per TMC. 1104.0601.
- 22. Dumpsters shall be screened from view and may not be located in any required setback or landscape buffers and as far from residential areas as possible. TMC 1108.0203.G: Shall be indicated on a revised site plan.
- 23. If applicable, new ground signage shall be limited one (1) low-profile monument sign per TMC 1387.02(2).
- 24. In addition to the existing landscaping at the site, a Type A landscape buffer of **two (2) new canopy trees and eight (8) shrubs along** the property line abutting the eastern residence to bring the site closer to compliance with the requirements of TMC§1108.0202: **Shall be indicated on a full landscaping site plan.**
- 25. The Special Use Permit may be reviewed for compliance with the conditions of approval, negative secondary effects, and adherence to all requirements of the Toledo Municipal Zoning Code. If outstanding issues are found and not addressed the Special Use Permit may be considered for revocation.
- 26. Minor adjustments to the site plan that do not violate the above conditions, or the Toledo Municipal Code, may be reviewed and approved by the Director of the Toledo City Plan Commission. Major adjustments will require an amendment to the Special Use Permit.
- 27. No permits shall be issued until arrangements satisfactory to the Director of the Toledo City Plan Commission have been made for compliance with the conditions as set forth above.

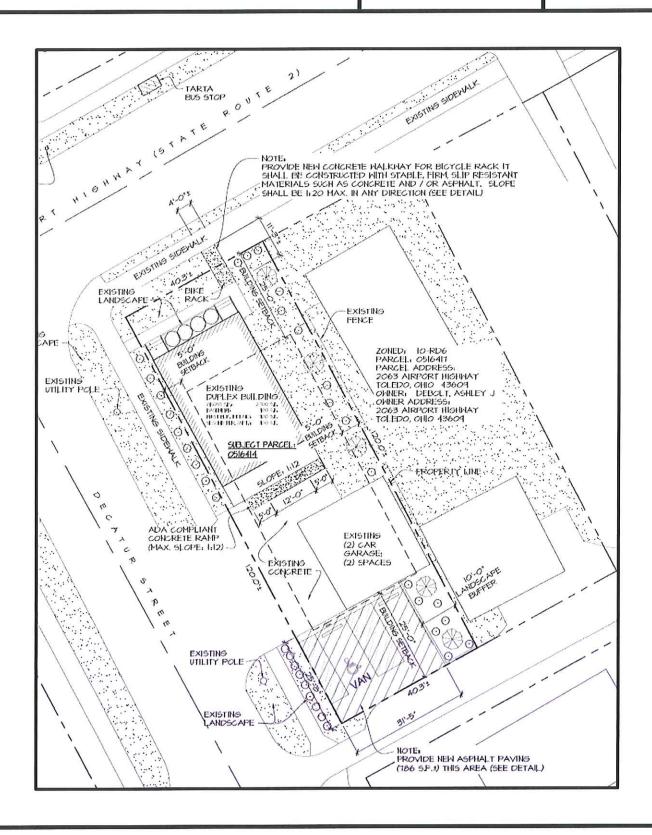

I'm a homeowner and neighbor to the property at 2067 Airport Highway and I wanted to share my concerns with the Zoning Change and Special Use Permit for the proposed convenience store at 2067 Airport Highway.

Attached is a Google map showing businesses within a mile radius offering the exact same service as the proposed location. I don't see the community benefiting from having another convenience store and all the issues that come along with them such as littering, loitering, increased neighborhood traffic, and criminal activity that is already an issue for my neighborhood. Across the street is a Tattoo/Barber Shop shop with lots of increased traffic and just this past week I witnessed it being surveilled by undercover cops this past week. Also, this part of Airport Highway is heavily trafficked throughout the day and is easily a traffic jam in the mornings and late afternoon hours.

Parking, zoning bring concerns for proposed Airport Highway carryout

The Toledo City Plan Commission is recommending against granting a special use permit for a proposed convenience store at 2067 Airport Highway.

The latest commission report cites inadequate parking and a location that fails to meet certain zoning requirements.

Currently, the lot on the corner of Airport Highway and Decatur Street is a vacant barber shop. Burroughs Neighborhood Organization President Robert Worthington said the prospect of another store has brought mixed feelings around the area.

"It's double edged, like, I'd rather have somebody in there, but then again, we have carry outs, gas stations, Dollar General every three or four blocks around here," he said. "So it doesn't seem necessary."

Per the Toledo Municipal Code, convenience stores are not allowed to be located within 2,000 feet of each other. They also cannot be located within 1,000 feet of a school, public park, library, or licensed day care center.

The proposed location is in too close of proximity to two existing stores, and would be too close to Highland Park.

Commission staff also determined that the building would be "not compatible" with the area, which is now mostly made up of single-family duplexes, outside of the tattoo parlor that sits on the same corner as the proposed site. Mr. Worthington said that the tattoo shop already attracts a steady flow of traffic to the corner.

"Allowing this use will exacerbate a challenging site location due to limited parking, potentially reducing residential on-street parking within the neighborhood. Additionally, there are two existing convenience stores within 1,000 feet of this site," the plan commission report reads.

Mr. Worthington, a former Toledo City Council candidate, also expressed concern with how a convenience store could impact traffic in the area.

"It backs up during rush hour," he said. "Even if there's a sign that's like 'don't turn onto Airport,' people are going to turn onto Airport and make it a mess."

Should the permit be granted, the site would also need to update its landscaping to become closer to compliance of the "neighborhood commercial" zone. Other conditions would include limiting store hours from 5:30 a.m. to 1 a.m., adding bicycle parking and ensuring store parking would not disrupt nearby residents.

Once the recommendation is confirmed by the commission, which is scheduled to meet next on Feb. 10, it will be up to Toledo City Council to decide whether or not to approve the store.

In recent months, council has had discussions and taken up legislation regarding convenience stores. They've weighed shutdowns for several different stores and in December they passed an ordinance that will bring new licensing requirements for stores beginning in May.



Plan commission rejects proposed Airport Highway carryout

The Toledo City Plan Commission voted 5-0 on Thursday to reject a zoning change and the granting of a special use permit for a proposed convenience store at 2067 Airport Hwy. in South Toledo.

Property owner Mohamed Shohatee and Angela Holm of Architecture by Design, the project architect, came forward together to advocate for approval.

The initial staff report cited issues with parking, zoning requirements, and a failure to meet spacing requirements. Ms. Holm said that they could resolve the parking situation by creating spaces behind the property's residential garage.

"It is a dirt area where people park anyhow, so what we were proposing was to just take that out and create actual parking spaces in the area," she told the commission. Mr. Shohatee testified that he went door-to-door around the neighborhood and collected at least 27 signatures of support for the project.

One nearby resident, Jason Palicki, testified that he's lived in the area for over a year and also talked to his neighbors, but didn't hear about any support from them for the store. He brought his concerns about more crime being attracted to the area by adding another carryout.

"What value is it going to bring, putting a fourth carryout in walking distance?" he said. "I can't get a fresh loaf of bread, a fresh piece of cheese, a fresh cut of meat, but I can get a pack of Marlboros and a beer in any direction of 800 [feet]."

Ultimately, the commission agreed with its staff report, which recommended disapproval of the zoning change and special use permit.

"There doesn't seem to be enough room for commercial traffic at that site... [and] it would seem to affect the character of the neighborhood," Vice Chairman Brandon Rehkopf said.

In other business Thursday, the commission approved making Toledo Municipal Code changes that would eliminate spacing requirements for convenience stores. New convenience store licensing requirements, passed by Toledo City Council in December, are set to go into effect in May.

Currently, the code prohibits stores from being within 2,000 feet of each other and within 1,000 feet of a school, public park, public library, and any day care or other facility "established specifically for the activities of minors."

Even if spacing requirements were removed from Airport Highway case, other factors still would have provided a challenge to gain approval from the plan commission.

The next step for both the proposed Airport Highway convenience store and the municipal code changes would be further review from Toledo City Council's Planning and Zoning Committee.
