Phase 3 of 3 is the completion of the Pathway for the Military Memorials. It is comprised of a walking path that encircles all the Memoral stones depicting names of those who gave their lives or is MIA from each war and are from Toledo, Lucas County. The pathway will be adorned with low maintenance foleage that will enhance the appeal of the walk. There will be benches where family, friends or anyone else who wishes to pay respect to those listed can sit. The backdrop is lush trees, to the right is a dirt path into the back woods and the eagles nests and to the left is the Westernmost Point of Lake Erie. To the north (short walking distance) is the Lighthouse and just a little further is Cullen Park and the Bird migration trail visited by 1,000's of bird watchers each year. It will become a destination spot Toledo can be proud of. This is all located on Toledo City property, parks.

Phase 1 Was to build the stones from each war and also a stone to honor Metal of Honor reciemients. Done and paid for by fund raising over \$90,000 2013 to 2019

Phase 2 Was to install a flag pole and pad with all branches of the military's flags. Done and Paid for by a grant from the Toledo Rotary Club and private funds. \$5,000 2019-2020

COVID hit and progress stopped. Meanwhile the existing 2 board members all elderly passed away some from COVID. The founder Nick Hauprich was diagnosed with dimentia 2020. He is currently in a nursing home and has gotten much worse. I, Debbie Speegle joining him in 2015 to raise money and build on his dream, promised I would see the completion through.
