

Penn 7 Engineering & Design Project Background

- Penn 7 (58.86 acres) is a former confined disposal facility on the lower Maumee River owned by the City of Toledo
- Site accepted material dredge from the Maumee River 1972-1973
- Current restoration plan will create fish habitat that progresses into an emergent wetland area
- Accepted funds will be used to:
 - Finalize the overall engineering and design
 - Acquire all necessary permits to complete future on-the-ground restoration
 - Begin public outreach and involvement
- A feasibility study was conducted by the City of Toledo in 2015-2016 which concluded that ecological restoration of Penn 7 should be pursued
- Future funding for the Penn 7 Project will ultimately result in the restoration
- Current funding will:
