

DPS – ReCommunity Recycling Processing
June 11, 2019

- The city's agreement with ReCommunity for recycling processing ends in July, 2019
- Currently, there are no other alternatives available for recycling processing
- Renewing the contract to January 1, 2022 will allow the city to continue to process single-stream recyclables and comply with the Solid Waste Management Plan, as approved by Council
- Also, the Lucas County Solid Waste Management District (LCSWMD) plans to develop a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) for processing of single-stream recyclables by 2022
- Renewing this contract to 2022 will put the expiration of this contract on the same schedule as the planned development of the LCSWMD MRF, which would be a more conducive time period to renegotiate contract terms or seek other bids to identify potential alternatives for recycling processing
- SEP is requested.
