- It is critical that the City act on this issue as soon as possible.

TLPPC'S RESPONSE TO THE PROPOSAL

- TLPPC sent a letter detailing its response. We shared this letter with City Council.
- We ask that the administration and city council address the three issues we raised in our letter as soon as possible.
- Once we address those three issues, we believe the City should pass a new lead ordinance immediately.



THE CLOCK IS TICKING

- TLPPC respectfully disagrees with the idea that the City can wait for other matters to be determined before passing a new ordinance.
- Countless children will be poisoned.



I. BUDGET AND STAFFING

- We ask that the administration please prepare a proposal for budgeting and staffing the implementation of the proposed ordinance.



2. DUST- WIPE TESTS NOW

- Begin dust-wipe testing as soon as possible.
- Reduce all delays in implementation as much as possible.



3. PHASE IN BASED ON POISONING RISKS

- Please return to phasing in the law based on lead poisoning risks, not square footage.

NEXT STEPS

- TLPPC asks that the administration please work with Council to provide a proposal for funding and staffing immediately.
- Then Council should promptly finalize and pass the ordinance.
