Bullet Points: 2020 CIP High Intensity Sign Ordinance

- The City of Toledo is required by federal mandate to meet high intensity sign requirements for signage.
- These funds will allow Transportation to purchase materials to replace existing signage with high intensity sign material.
- This will be a multiyear project requiring funding until all signage is complete, estimated to be 8 years.
- We have the city divided into 105 sectors, we can complete approximately 9-10 sectors a year. To date we have 33 sectors completed. Each year we make sure we are completing sectors in each of the 6 Districts.
- All roadway signage is being replaced (Regulatory-stops, speed limits, parking, lane control; Warning(Yellow)-curve ahead, merge; Informational-street name, hospital, directional)
