Section 2. License. The last sentence of Section 2.C. (Termination) which reads, "Moreover, either party shall have the unilateral right to terminate Agreement for convenience at any time thirty (30) days after written notice to the other party", is deleted.	
Section 5. Term, Renewal, Subsection A. Subsection A of Section 5 of the Agreements is amended to read to as follows: "The Initial Service term shall be for a period of five years, subject to annual appropriations by Toledo City Council, and will commence on the date that the Service is available to the Customer via the Alert Console."	
Section 5. Term, Renewal, Subsection B. The first sentence of Subsection B of Section 5 of the Agreement is amended to read as follows: "After the initial term, Service maybe renewed for successive period of one year each, in accordance with the following procedure."	
The First Amendment amends and modifies the term of the Agreement only to the extent expressly provided herein. All other terms and provisions of the Agreement area affirmed and ratified.
