DEDICATION OF RIGHTS-OF-WAY AT CITY PARK AND THE AW TRAIL BULLET POINTS

- The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) recently completed a bridge reconstruction project on the AW Trail over railroad tracks near City Park Avenue.
- Certain utility facilities at or near the project site need to be relocated as a result of these new roadway and bridge improvements.
- There is currently insufficient rights-of-way along City Park Avenue at the AW Trail to accommodate the necessary utility relocations.
- The City of Toledo is the fee owner of certain real estate that runs along the AW Trail between Collingwood Avenue and City Park Avenue.
- This ordinance will dedicate a small portion of City-owned land as public right of way, which will straighten out the right of way limits along City Park Avenue and provide sufficient rights-of-way to accommodate the necessary utility relocations.
