Packer Truck Purchase

- The current fleet of packer trucks were originally purchased and used in the division of solid waste when the city did on street refuse collection.
- Streets, Bridges & Harbor has never purchased new packer trucks.
- Thirteen (13) Trucks are 2003, Two (2) are 2004, Three (3) are 2005, Three (3) are 2007.
- Purchase is necessary due to five (5) packer trucks going out of service in one month and are not repairable.
- Packer trucks are used in street sweeping, blight cleanup, alley cleaning and leaf collection.
- A bid was put out to rent packer trucks but no bidders came back as a result.
- An attempt was made to rent from multiple vendors but no trucks were found to be available.

Purchase of three (3) used 25 yard packer trucks from Bell Equipment for \$430,500.

- All three (3) are 2016 Freightliner M2 Chassis. These are the same chassis, engine and transmission we currently have in a majority of our trucks.
- Each truck cost is \$143,500
- Each truck is under 100,000 miles with under 300 engine hours.
- 25 yard Heil DP5000 bodies. These are similar to what SB&H currently has in use.
- Bell Equipment is giving a \$7,000 180 day warranty for parts and labor.
- Trucks will be delivered in time for leaf season.

Purchase of two (2) new 25 yard packer trucks from New Way Refuse Sales for \$425,755.94 total

- Purchase will be through Sourcewell pricing.
- Each truck cost is \$212,877.97
- Trucks are brand new 2022 models on International chassis.
- 25 yard capacity. Same size as the trucks that they will be replacing.
