



### FUTURE SITE TOLEDO PAL'S MULTIPURPOSE SPORTS FIELD











( N FEET ) 1 inch = 20 m.



PAL Staff and Coaches Responsibility

- COVID 19 Awareness
- Mentoring Sessions before practices
- Each Student and Coach must sign Covid-19 waivers
- Protecting Students from Abuse at (Home, School, Field)
- Heat Illness Protections
- Protection from bullying, Hazing and inappropriate behaviors
- ACL injury prevention
- Coaches and other volunteers having direct contact with students will be provided a Toledo PAL Badge with photo that must be worn during game.
