#### STAFF ANALYSIS

The applicant is requesting the Vacation of the 20ft strip of land along Front Street from Marina Drive to the Craig Bridge Street. The applicant, Metroparks Toledo, owns the adjacent property to the northwest. Metroparks Toledo is currently developing the previously approved Phase II of the Glass City Metroparks at Front Street, and the completed park will extend between Morrison Drive and the Craig Bridge Street. Surrounding land uses include the Glass City Metropark to the north; Tribute Park to the south; the Craig Street Bridge and I-280 to the east; and the Glass City Metropark, a marina, and the National Museum of the Great Lakes to the west.

The applicant is requesting the Vacation in order to facilitate the expansion of the Glass City Metropark. The previously approved Special Use Permit of Phase II of the Glass City Metropark proposed the property to the north be for urban camping, and the vacated area contains a tree line which will buffer the campsite from Front Street. The area requesting to be vacated was previously ramps for I-280, however since the Veterans Glass City Bridge was constructed, the roadways in this location have been reconfigured and the right-of-way is no longer necessary to serve the infrastructure. On 08/17/2021, City Council approved a declaration of intent (*Res. 447-21*) to Vacate the requested portion of Front Street.

### Connecting the Pieces Plan

The 2008 Connecting the Pieces Plan identifies this strip of land as a trail to connect to proposed parks. The trail was constructed along with the Veterans Glass City Bridge project, and serves as bicycle and pedestrian access along Front Street. The trail will remain with the proposed Glass City Metropark, and further fulfill the Connecting the Pieces Plan vision of building vibrant public spaces in East Toledo.

## Toledo 20/20 Comprehensive Plan

The Toledo 20/20 Comprehensive Plan future land designation targets the proposed adjacent land as Urban Village. This land use category is a specialized residential and commercial district that possesses characteristics of Traditional Neighborhood Development (TND), such as pedestrian orientation, zero building setbacks, mixed uses, and district architectural character. The proposed Vacation area will be added to Glass City Metropark, and will be a valuable public amenity.

#### STAFF ANALYSIS (cont'd)

Staff recommends approval of the proposed Vacation as it will not impede or restrict access to any adjoining property owners abutting the site. Additionally, the request conforms to the goals of the Connecting the Pieces Plan.

#### PLAN COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

The Toledo City Plan Commission recommends approval of V-447-21, the request for the Vacation of the 20ft strip of land along Front Street from Marina Drive to the Craig Bridge Street to Toledo City Council for the following two (2) reasons:

- 1. The proposed Vacation will not impede or restrict access to any property owners abutting the site; and,
- 2. The proposed Vacation conforms to the Toledo 20/20 Comprehensive Plan and the 2008 Connecting the Pieces Plan (TMC§1111.0606(A) *Review & Decision-Making Criteria*).

The Toledo City Plan Commission further recommends approval of V-447-21, the request to Vacate the 20ft strip of land along Front Street from Marina Drive to the Craig Bridge Street to Toledo City Council subject to the following **four (4)** conditions:

### Division of Transportation

3. Within the limits allowed by law, the applicant shall indemnify the City of Toledo, its officials, agents or employees, from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, suits or liability in connection with the performance of any and all acts authorized or permitted under this vacation. Said indemnification language shall be contained within and evidenced by the endorsement on a certified copy of the final vacating legislation by the owner which indemnification shall be kept in the permanent file of the Clerk of Council.

### Plan Commission

4. Any revisions to the previously approved Special Use Permit for the Glass City Metropark shall be viewed by the Plan Commission as a minor amendment or a major amendment per TMC§1111.0708 – Amendments to Approved Special Uses.


