SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

The City of Toledo has been awarded \$500,000 through a Great Lakes Restoration Initiative grant to perform stream bank enhancements and erosion control measures along the portion of Delaware Creek that falls inside Delaware Creek Park. The rear portion of the property at 1665 Watova Rd. stretches down the ravine to the edge of the creek. Through execution of this .11-acre acquisition we will be able to perform the full scope of stream bank enhancements necessary to stabilize the creek and prevent future erosion issues. The costs of the acquisition and associated fees are allowable expenses under the grant terms.

The current owner of the property has expressed a desire to sell this portion of the property to the City of
