Declaring the intent to vacate all of the existing right of way of Magnolia from the southeasterly right of way of vacated Water Street to the northwesterly Harbor line of the Maumee River and all of the full existing right of way of Olive Street from the southeasterly right of way of vacated Water Street to the northwesterly harbor line of the Maumee River and all of the full existing right of way of Elm Street lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right of way of Water Street prolonged to the northeast to the northwesterly harbor line of the Maumee River, in Toledo, Lucas County Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

Petitioner has filed a request to vacate all of the existing right of way of Magnolia from the southeasterly right of way of vacated Water Street to the northwesterly Harbor line of the Maumee River and all of the full existing right of way of Olive Street from the southeasterly right of way of vacated Water Street to the northwesterly harbor line of the Maumee River and all of the full existing right of way of Elm Street lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right of way of Water Street prolonged to the northeast to the northwesterly harbor line of the Maumee River in Toledo, Lucas County Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intent to vacate all of the existing right of way of Magnolia from the southeasterly right of way of vacated Water Street to the northwesterly Harbor line

of the Maumee River and all of the full existing right of way of Olive Street from the southeasterly right of way of vacated Water Street to the northwesterly harbor line of the Maumee River and all of the full existing right of way of Elm Street lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right of way of Water Street prolonged to the northeast to the northwesterly harbor line of the Maumee River further described below:

All of the existing right of way of Magnolia from the southeasterly right of way of vacated Water Street to the northwesterly Harbor line of the Maumee River and

All of the full existing right of way of Olive Street from the southeasterly right of way of vacated Water Street to the northwesterly harbor line of the Maumee River and

All of the full existing right of way of Elm Street lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right of way of Water Street prolonged to the northeast to the northwesterly harbor line of the Maumee River

SECTION 2. That this matter be referred to the Toledo City Plan Commission for its review, recommendation and appropriate hearing date.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution hereby is declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective so that the vacation can be expeditiously completed to enable property owners to obtain the resulting benefits at the earliest time.
