### Recognizing Ms. Nina Corder for winning the Toledo-area Jefferson Award.

WHEREAS, the Jefferson Awards are known as “an American Nobel Prize for public service.” founded in 1972 by Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, Sam Beard, and Senator Robert Taft Jr., the Jefferson Awards has honored individuals for outstanding public service; and
