Declaring the intent to vacate the 16-foot-wide alley running North and South and adjacent to Lots 20, 21-28 and 29 for a total distance of 240 Feet. Also, the 16-foot-wide alley running east and west and being adjacent to lots 18-20 and 29-31 for a total distance of 94.5 feet all within the Plat of Hanson Addition and fully within the City of Toledo, Lucas County Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

Petitioner has filed a request to vacate two separate alley way lying east of East Broadway and between Hanson Avenue and Oakdale Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intent to vacate two separate alley way lying east of East Broadway and between Hanson Avenue and Oakdale Avenue, further described below:

The 16-foot-wide alley running North and South and adjacent to Lots 20, 21-28 and 29 for a total distance of 240 Feet. Also, the 16-foot-wide alley running east and west and being adjacent to lots 18-20 and 29-31 for a total distance of 94.5 feet all within the Plat of Hanson Addition and fully within the City of Toledo, Lucas County Ohio;

SECTION 2. That this matter be referred to the Toledo City Plan Commission for its review, recommendation and appropriate hearing date.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution hereby is declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective so that the vacation can be expeditiously completed to enable property owners to obtain the resulting benefits at the earliest time.
