Declaring the intent to vacate a 100 foot by 30-foot alley running NE and SW from 142<sup>nd</sup> Street to 144<sup>th</sup> Street and adjacent to lots 56,57,58 and 59 and 83,84, 85 and 86 of the Warner Place 3<sup>rd</sup> extension subdivision, in the City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

## SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

Petitioner has filed a request to vacate 100 foot by 30 foot alley running NE and SW from 142<sup>nd</sup> Street to 144<sup>th</sup> Street and adjacent to lots 56, 57, 58 and 59 and 83, 84, 85 and 86 of the Warner Place 3<sup>rd</sup> Extension Subdivision, in the City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intent to vacate 100 foot by 30-foot alley running NE and SW from 142<sup>nd</sup> Street to 144<sup>th</sup> Street and adjacent to lots 56, 57, 58 and 59 and 83, 84, 85 and 86 of the Warner Place 3<sup>rd</sup> extension subdivision, in the City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That this matter be referred to the Toledo City Plan Commission for its review, recommendation and appropriate hearing date.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution hereby is declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective so that the vacation can be expeditiously completed to enable

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property owners to obtain the resulting benefits	at the earliest time.
