Declaring the intent to vacate a 16-foot-wide Alley running North and South and lying between the Northerly 5.00 feet of Lot 5 together with all of Lots 6 thru 9 and Lot 10 within the Pomeroy's Lagrange Manor Extension, for the full length of 125.00 feet, all within the city of Toledo, Lucas County Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

Petitioner has filed a request to vacate the alley running south off E. Lake Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intent to vacate the alley further described below:

Being a 16-foot-wide Alley running North and South and lying between the Northerly 5.00 feet of Lot 5 together with all of Lots 6 thru 9 and Lot 10 within the Pomeroy's Lagrange Manor Extension, for the full length of 125.00 feet, all within the city of Toledo, Lucas County Ohio.

SECTION 2. That this matter be referred to the Toledo City Plan Commission for its review, recommendation and appropriate hearing date.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution hereby is declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property, and for the further reason that this

Resolution must be immediately effective so that the vacation can be expeditiously completed to enable property owners to obtain the resulting benefits at the earliest time.
