DPYS 2022 Cullen Park Flush Restroom Facility \$200,000

Authorizing the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$200,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of a flush restroom facility at Cullen Park; authorizing the Mayor to accept bids and award contracts for said purpose; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

This ordinance authorizes expending up to \$200,000 for the purchase and installation of a flush restroom facility at Cullen Park. The park is used heavily by boaters, fishermen, kayakers, and bird watchers. Funds for this project are included in the approved Capital Improvement budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. The expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$200,000 is authorized from the Capital Improvement Fund Account Code 5040-26100-8CP2223CULRES for the purchase and installation of a flush restroom facility at Cullen Park.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to accept bids and award contracts for the purposes specified in Section 1 upon terms and conditions as acceptable to the Director of Law and the Director of Parks and Youth Services.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to draw warrant or warrants against the above account code in payment of the above authorized obligations in amounts not to exceed \$200,000 upon presentation of the proper voucher or vouchers.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that the same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective in order to timely construct the Cullen Park restroom facility for proper and safe use.

Vote on emergency clause: yeas 12, nays 0.

Passed: August 16, 2022 as an emergency measure: yeas 12, nays 0.
