DPYS 2022 Pine Glen Paved Trail Improvements \$100,000 Parks, Recreation & Community Enrichment Karen Ranney Wolkins (x2326)/Joe Fausnaugh (x3884) Revised

Authorizing the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$100,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for pavement improvements at Pine Glen Park; authorizing the Mayor to accept bids and award contracts for said purpose; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

This ordinance authorizes expending up to \$100,000 for pavement improvements to the trail at Pine Glen Park. An evaluation of the pavement at Pine Glen park resulted in a recommendation of the proposed asphalt improvement techniques to extend the life of the existing paved trail and parking lots. This project will also ensure that the paved trail remains barrier-free and accessible to all city residents through the replacement of several sections of trail that have been severely damaged by tree roots. Funds for this project were allocated in the approved mid-year budget adjustment to the Capital Improvement fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. The expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$100,000 is authorized from the Capital Improvement Fund Account Code 5040-40100-8CP2215PRKIMP for pavement improvements to the paved trail at Pine Glen Park.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to accept bids and award contracts for the purposes specified in Section 1, upon terms and conditions as acceptable to the Director of Law and the Director of Parks and Youth Services.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to draw warrant or warrants against the above account code in payment of the above authorized obligations in amounts not to exceed \$100,000 upon presentation of the proper voucher or vouchers.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that the same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective in order to timely improve the Pine Glen Park paved trail for proper and safe use.

Vote on emergency clause: yeas 11, nays 0.
