## SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

Petitioner has filed a request to vacate the 10-foot wide alley running north and south from Erie Street and adjacent to Lots 6-10 in the PalmerzBlair Subdivision and lots 1-5 of the McElroy's Subdivision all located within the Stickney Addition lying in the City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intent to vacate the 10-foot wide alley running north and south from Erie Street and adjacent to Lots 6-10 in the PalmerzBlair Subdivision and lots 1-5 of the McElroy's Subdivision all located within the Stickney Addition in the City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That this matter be referred to the Toledo City Plan Commission for its review, recommendation and appropriate hearing date.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution hereby is declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective so that the vacation can be expeditiously completed to enable
