This ordinance is for approval of a contract and expenditures for supplemental staffing services citywide as part of the City of Toledo's Seasonal, Intern, and Temporary program. This ordinance authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Job1USA, Inc. for citywide staffing services as part of the seasonal, intern, and temporary program.
