### **Recognizing Mr. Michael Malone on his retirement as Executive Director of Manahan, an organization dedicated to serving individuals with developmental disabilities.**

WHEREAS, Mr. Michael Malone is retiring as the Executive Director of Manahan previously known as Josina Lott, after spending forty years working with people in the disability community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Malone is a lifelong Northwest Ohio resident who graduated from St. John's Jesuit High School, the University of Toledo, and Lourdes University as well as from the Leadership Toledo program; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Malone took the lessons he learned from his sister, who was born with Down Syndrome and turned that knowledge into a long career of helping people and offering them quality care; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Malone was a dedicated servant leader in the community serving as one of Ohio Provider Resource Association's District 4 Representatives from 2016 to 2019; In 2016, Mr. Malone helped form MemoryLane Care Services, a private, local nonprofit serving area residents and their families affected by Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia, and remains one of its board members; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Malone plans to work on improving his golf game and finally reading a stack of books that he always meant to read; NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That we wish Mr. Michael Malone a long and happy retirement and encourage others to be leaders in the community and follow his example.
