Declaring the intent to vacate a 16-foot alley running Northwest to Southeast adjacent to lots 21 through 31 and Lot 34 of the Highland Addition, together with a 15-foot alley adjacent to Lots 33 and 34 in the Highland Addition, Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

## **SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:**

Petitioner has filed a request to vacate the alley running adjacent to their building located at 2250 N. Detroit Avenue, Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intent to vacate the alley further described below:

A 16-foot alley running Northwest to Southeast adjacent to lots 21 through 31 and Lot 34 of the Highland Addition, Toledo, Lucas County Ohio. Together with a 15-foot alley adjacent to Lots 33 and 34 in the Highland Addition, Lucas County Ohio

SECTION 2. That this matter be referred to the Toledo City Plan Commission for its review, recommendation and appropriate hearing date.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution hereby is declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective so that the vacation can be expeditiously completed to enable

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property owners to obtain the resulting benefits at the earliest time.
