Declaring the intent to vacate the 20 ft alley running east and west between Montain Rd. and Westhaven Rd., adjacent to lots 66 and 53 in the Reynolds Place Subdivision all within the City of Toledo, Lucas County Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

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City Council

Petitioner has filed a request to vacate the 20 ft alley running east and west between Montain Rd and Westhaven Rd, adjacent to lots 66 and 53 in the Reynolds Place Subdivision in Toledo, Lucas County Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby declare its intent to vacate the alley further described below:

DESCRIPTION OF 20' WIDE ALLEY

A 20' WIDE ALLEY, 240' IN LENGTH, LOCATED IN THE CITY OF TOLEDO IN REYNOLDS PLACE SUBDIVISION (PV 43, PAGE 53) AND BOUNDED ON THE WEST BY MONTAIN ROAD (60' R/W), ON THE EAST BY WESTHAVEN ROAD (60' R/W), ON THE NORTH BY LOTS #4-#10 IN SAID SUBDIVISION, AND ON THE SOUTH BY LOTS #66 & #53 IN SAID SUBDIVISION.

SECTION 2. That this matter be referred to the Toledo City Plan Commission for its review, recommendation and appropriate hearing date.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution hereby is declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that same is necessary for

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the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective so that the vacation can be expeditiously completed to enable property owners to obtain the resulting benefits at the earliest time.
