Zoning & Planning Committee

Changing the zoning maps attached to Part 11, Planning and Zoning, Toledo Municipal Code, for the property located at 3319 Nebraska Avenue, in the City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

An application (Z-7002-18) for a proposed change in zoning for the property located at 3319 Nebraska Avenue, Toledo, Ohio, was submitted to the Toledo City Plan Commission for its review and recommendation.

On September 13, 2018, the Toledo City Plan Commission recommended approval of the request for a zone change from "RM12" Multi Dwelling Residential and "IL" Limited Industrial to "RS6" Single Family Residential for the property located at 3319 Nebraska Avenue, Toledo, Ohio.

The City Council Zoning and Planning Committee on October 17, 2018, sent as approved the request for a zone change from "RM12" Multi Dwelling Residential and "IL" Limited Industrial to "RS6" Single Family Residential "for the property located at 3319 Nebraska Avenue, Toledo, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the zoning maps attached to Part 11, Planning and Zoning, Toledo Municipal Code, are hereby authorized to be revised by changing the zone districts of that part of the City of Toledo more fully described as follows:

The northwest one-quarter (1/4) of the southwest one-quarter (1/4) of Section five (5), Town three (3), United States Reserve of 12 miles square at the foot of the Rapids of the Miami of Lake Erie, in the City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio, excepting therefrom the south one (1) rod thereof and also excepting therefrom the north six hundred sixty (66) feet of the west six hundred eight (580) feet, lying south of the north six hundred sixty (66) feet thereof; subject to legal highways.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Toledo City Plan Commission is hereby authorized and directed to make the said change on the original zoning maps.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance hereby is declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in force and effect from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that same is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property, and for the further reason that the Ordinance must be immediately effective in order to provide for the orderly regulation and use of the property and to protect the land value in the area.
