Portable Radio Purchase 2020 Fire & Rescue Department CFO Verdell Franklin (x3515) Revised

Authorizing the expenditure of \$115,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of portable radios; authorizing the Mayor to accept bids and award contracts for said purchase; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

The Toledo Fire and Rescue Department requests authorization to purchase much needed portable radios due to the fact that as of December 2018, the department's current radios are no longer supported by the manufacturer.

The fiscal impact of this ordinance is as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Toledo:

SECTION 1. That the sum of \$115,000 is authorized for expenditure from the Capital Improvement Fund, Account Code 5040-53000-8CP1926FIRRAD for the purchase of portable radios.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to prepare plans and specifications, to accept bids and enter into contracts necessary to complete the purchase. Said contracts shall contain such terms and conditions as the Mayor may deem requisite and proper and shall be subject to approval by the Department of Law and the Director of Fire.

SECTION 3. That the Director of Finance is authorized to draw his warrant or warrants against the Account Code above in an amount not to exceed \$115,000 in payment of the obligations authorized above upon presentation of the proper voucher or vouchers.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance, being an emergency measure, shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that the ordinance is necessary to ensure that the Toledo Fire and Rescue Department has updated vital radio equipment and is able obtain communication equipment supported by the manufacturer.

Vote on emergency clause: yeas 12, nays 0.
