DPS CIP Infrastructure Improvements \$100,000 Solid Waste Scott Lockhart (X 2642)/Paul M. Rasmusson (X7868) Revised

Authorizing the expenditure of \$100,000 from the Capital Improvement (CIP) Fund for various infrastructure projects at the Hoffman Road Landfill; authorizing the mayor to accept bids and award contracts for said infrastructure improvements; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

Landfill infrastructure improvements are necessary to maintain compliance with regulatory operational requirements, minimize risk associated with system failures and enhance the overall facility aesthetics. The landfill is a multi-faceted environment requiring supporting mechanical, electrical, administrative, and civil engineering related infrastructure to operate effectively and remain in compliance with local, state, and federal rules/permits.
