DPS Ball Field Repair and Restoration \$75,000 Parks, Recreation and Forestry Karen Ranney Wolkins (x2326)/Paul M. Rasmusson (x7868) Revised

Authorizing the expenditure of \$75,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the improvements at the Detwiler Park ball field; authorizing the Mayor to accept bids and award contracts for said improvements; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

The ball field complex at Detwiler Park has long been the site of a robust schedule of baseball tournaments and ongoing competitive play. Over the years, field 4, closest to Mud Creek, has consistently experienced long periods of flooding. These funds will provide for the installation of a drainage system to prevent flooding and allow for regular play on this field all season long.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to accept the bids and award contracts for the purposes specified in Section 1, upon terms and conditions acceptable to the Directors of Public Service and Law.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to draw his warrant or warrants against the account code in Section 1, in payment of the above authorized obligations in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 upon presentation of the proper voucher or vouchers.
