DPU072021PROMISEPAY Utilities Administration C. Geronimo (x2363) Revised

Authorizing the mayor to enter into a one-year pilot program agreement for Department of Public Utility accounts receivable collection services and customer affordability program management services; authorizing the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$310,000 from the Utilities Administrative Services Fund; waiving the competitive bidding requirements of T.M.C. 187; and declaring an emergency.

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

Promise Network Inc. ("Promise") is a financial technology company that believes in supporting both public and private agencies and their customers. Promise works to implement cutting-edge technology to enhance agency efficiency and improve customer experience while enhancing the revenue of the public agency. Their portal allows their clients to rapidly distribute financial assistance grants from local, state and Federal sources, such as The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act and Low-Income Water Assistance Program (LIWAP). Their third-party Pledge Portal gives Community Action Organizations and other partners access to relevant account information necessary to provide relief funds.
