# Hiring and Retirements

- Current Uniformed Staffing – 583
- 2026 Separations/Retirements
  - 1 YTD
  - 9 additional confirmed upcoming
- Fire Class Update
  - 20 fire recruits began academy 7/31/2026
  - Graduation 2027

# 2026 Response Data

(Through March, 2026)

- Total Incidents – **15,513**
  - 1.4% increase over 2025
    - Avg: 172/Day
- Fire Incidents – **2,543**
  - Structure Fires: 49
- EMS Incidents – **12,970**
- Total Responses through March 31 2026 – **28,284**
  - 3.8% increase over 2025
    - Avg: 314/day

# 2026 Response Data

(Through March, 2026)

- Busiest Apparatus by type
  - Medic 3 (701 Bush) – 1,012 responses
  - Engine 23 (2743 W. Laskey) – 1,172 responses
  - Heavy Rescue 7 (2155 Franklin) – 1,142 responses
  - Tower Ladder 17 (1041 W. Central) – 284 responses
- Ambulance Transports
  - Through March – 6,219
  - Average of 69 per day
  - 1.8% Decrease over 2025

# Fire Prevention Bureau

(Through March, 2026)

- Fire inspections - 641
- Fire/sprinkler plans reviewed - 230
- Building preplans - 10
- Code Red properties mitigated - 12
- CERP distributed and installed 505 smoke alarms

# 2026 Highlights

- Fire Station building maintenance improvements ongoing
  - roof at HQ, HVAC, apparatus floor replacement, waterproofing at 21s, kitchens, concrete, and more
- Fire vehicle replacement
  - Received - 4 engines
  - 3 ambulances (est. delivery date Q1 2027)
  - 2 ambulances sent for remount soon
