

EXHIBIT A

SECTION 1. That Toledo Municipal Code §1104.2800 is enacted to state as follows:

§1104.2800 Detention Facility

For purposes of this section, a “detention facility” is privately or publicly owned building, structure, or erection, whether temporary or permanent, primarily designed to house and restrict the movement of individuals who are held in the custody of a federal, state or local governmental agency.

SECTION 2. That Toledo Municipal Code §1104.2801 is enacted to state as follows:

§1104.2801 Special Use Permit Required

A. After the effective date of this section, any detention facility proposed to be created, expanded, or modified requires a special use permit to operated. A special use permit shall only be granted upon satisfaction of the following:

1. The proposed detention facility complies with all safety, fire, health, housing and building codes.
2. The proposed detention facility complies with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations related to security, control, and health management.
3. Documentation is provided that ensures the size of the existing or proposed detention facility has sufficient allocation of space for the estimated number of detainees.
