II. Applications

a. Schneider Park Facility and Equipment Improvements Application

Fausnaugh presented a thorough overview of the proposed project. The Department of Parks and Youth Services plans to select a contractor through a bidding process. Fausnaugh highlighted the importance of acquiring a utility vehicle to prevent soccer clubs from driving on the fields. The department aims to complete the installation of an accessible playground by the end of the year. The funding gap between the requested \$230,563 and the total project cost of \$355,563, amounting to \$125,000, will be sought in the upcoming mid-year budget adjustment. The cost estimates are based on recent figures from similar projects undertaken by the department.
